The attached list of textbooks will be available at bookshops specifically Aristata (previously Protea) Bookshop, in Hatfield. Books should be purchased by end of November 2026 to prevent stock shortages in January 2027.

Compulsory Extra Fee:

Gr. 11 Compulsory Extra fees for 2027 is R2165 which includes, amongst others, exam pads (for tests and exams), the school diary, merits, speakers, 23 – 25 June camp, etc. This fee must be paid by the end of January 2027. These amounts will be reflected on your January 2027 statement.

Second-hand textbooks:

Second hand textbooks (NOT workbooks) can be bought privately. However, please ensure that it is one that your daughter needs for 2027 (as indicated on the attached booklist).

Learners have been given the opportunity to sell their second-hand textbooks in the course of the year through the Deputy Principal. Each book has the learner's own set price. Parents are welcome to peruse these textbooks. However, please note that it is a cash sale.

Subject Choice; Dramatic Arts requirements for practical sessions:

If your daughter is doing Dramatic Arts (as a choice subject) the following items are necessary for the practical sessions and in particular the practical end-of-year component

1. Black loose-fitting shirt with no print or logos on.
2. Black tracksuit pants with no print or logos on.
3. White tekkies (as for sports uniform).

Subject Choice: CAT

If your daughter is doing CAT (as a choice subject) the following specifications are essential:
